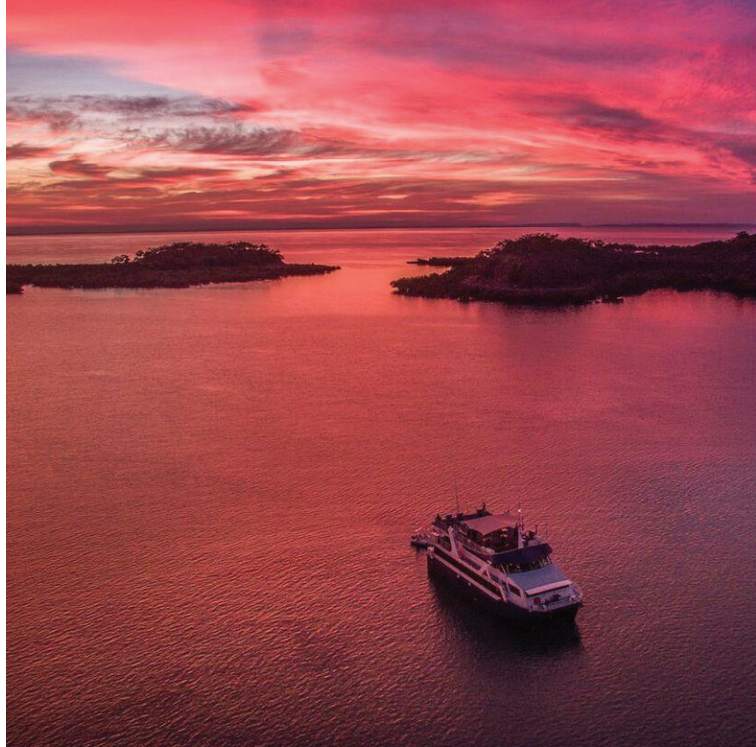

Things to Note

Traditional Owner Visitor Passes

- All visitors must pay access fees (\$200–\$300 pp), which are added to your booking.

Bar Service

- Discovery One is a licensed vessel. Drinks are available at reasonable bar prices.

Horizontal Falls Powerboat Ride

- Optional add-on arranged onboard (~\$120 pp).

Flexible Itinerary

- Subject to tides, weather, and operational conditions.

Solo Travellers

- Option to share a cabin or upgrade to a private one (+50%).

Cabin Comfort

- All cabins are air-conditioned with pillow-top mattresses — no bunks.

Window Cabin Upgrade

- \$500 pp / \$1,000 per cabin.
