
Honouring Country and Culture

We are deeply grateful for their permission to visit these sacred places and pay our respects to Elders past, present, and emerging. From the Uunguu Indigenous Protected Area, where Wunambal Gaambera Rangers care for Country "the right way," to Dambimangari Saltwater Country, home of the sacred Wandjina spirits, and eastward to Balanggarra Country — rich with rock art, storylines, and language — this is Country alive with cultural knowledge and purpose.

At Discovery One, we honour this deep heritage by walking respectfully, supporting Traditional Owner visitor programs, and maintaining a low-impact approach to travel. For over 25 years, we've operated with care for people, planet, and place — sourcing fresh local produce, partnering with regional suppliers, and committing to tourism that gives back.
